Required Medical

- Fully Completed BSA Health Form
- ALL medications (prescribed, over-the-counter, vitamins, etc), marked with name, in sealed zip bag

Cook-out

- Mess Kit and utensils

Clothes

- Extra shorts or pants
- Extra Shirts
- Daily change or underwear & socks
- Bathing suit
- Rain gear
- Pajamas/Sleep wear
- Sweater, Fleece or jacket
- Hat
- Comfortable hiking shoes
- Sneakers or moccasins
- Scout uniform (Class A and other class as directed by your unit)
- Comfortable hiking shoes

Sleep/Bedding

- Sleeping bag or three warm blankets
- Mattress cover or sheet
- Pillow

Storage

- Footlocker, duffel bag or pack

Personal Hygiene/Shower

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Soap in container
- Hand towels and bath towels
- Shower clogs, flip flops, or sandals
- Comb and brush

Merit Badge Classes

- Scout Handbook
- Merit badge booklets
- Pen/pencils and small notebook

Misc Optional Items

- Watch
- Laundry Bag
- Canteen/Water Bottles
- Bible or prayer book
- Individual first aid kit
- Camera and film (throw-away type camera best)
- Clothes hangers
- Nature guides, books, etc.
- Fishing tackle and pole
- Steel Mirror
- Flashlight and batteries
- Insect repellent
- Sun screen
